



PARTNERSHIP WITH THE RA GOVERNMENT TO ELIMINATE DISASTER ZONE HOUSING PROBLEM

Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan traveled to Lori Marz on the 31st anniversary of the December 7, 1988 earthquake. The Premier first visited Shirakamut (Nalband) village, the epicenter of the devastating earthquake. Nikol Pashinyan paid tribute to the memory of those innocent victims who died in the earthquake and laid a wreath at the monument-khachkar located near the Shirakamut municipality.

The Premier then visited Lernantsk community to attend the inauguration of a block of flats built for local residents. Within the framework of the Disaster Zone State Housing Program, 8 apartments were built by the Fuller Center for Housing Armenia Non-Governmental Organizations at the expense of government funding.

Nikol Pashinyan congratulated the beneficiaries on housewarming, wished them every success and progress, noting that the government was consistent in resolving the disaster zone housing problem. The Government has launched the construction of 24 new high-rise apartments, 4 of them in Lernantsk.

Prime Minister Pashinyan talked to the residents of Shirakamut, Spitak and Lernantsk communities, learned their concerns and answered their questions. The Prime Minister presented the disaster zone housing programs, highlighting the ongoing government-community-regional administration cooperation in the context of community development and subsidy programs.
